What is included? This gift will include a wedding service by a certified captain (or other preferred official) onboard the largest vessel at the Detroit Boat Show – the Queen of the show which is likely to be 48 – 50 feet in length. Also included will be the invitations, coordination, music, witnesses, photography, setup, food, cake, flowers and one room night at the Courtyard Marriott Downtown Detroit for the bride and groom. The number of wedding guests will be limited to 30. The items provided are package items and are chosen by the show with limited input from the bride and groom.

What couple must provide. The lucky couple must provide all aspects not listed above including, but not limited to attire, valid Michigan marriage license and rings. Couple will be responsible for notifying guests.
